 expectations of tourism workers, providing a basis for the development of training tools.
- Online course "Tourism-Pro: Enhancing the Skills of Tourism Professionals": an innovative training program divided into modules focusing on digital skills, soft skills, customer management, and sustainability.
- Manual on soft and digital skills: a comprehensive guide offering tools to improve business management, with a focus on innovation, sustainability, and resilience.
